Track record	Evidence of esteem including but not limited to: publication record, previous grant funding, and 3Rs engagement

	<ul> <li>Hypothesis, scientific and 3Rs objectives are clearly articulated</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Demonstration of clear and substantial 3Rs impact (including logical and realistic metrics)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Inclusion of a strong plan to achieve a lasting 3Rs legacy</li> </ul>
Environment (Training and Research)	For Studentships:
	<ul> <li>Evidence of a strong training and development programme (scientific, 3Rs and pastoral)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Evidence that the student will be provided with appropriate support, guidance and mentorship throughout their studies</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Demonstrable support from the research organisation</li> </ul>
